

“SCRAMBLE” GOLF TOURNAMENT

RULES FOR PLAY

The following is an explanation and the directions of how your **four**-person team will play. Use the **Team** score card assigned to your foursome.

In the upper section of your “TEAM score card”, enter the order of your **four** players. In the lower section of your score card, you will note one entry that reads: “Scramble Score”. You will make one entry for your team score.

Begin play on the designated tee box, **men (17-69) on the white tees, men 16 and under and 70-79 from the gold tees, ladies and men over 80 play from the red tees.**

Once everyone has hit his/her tee shot, the Team Captain selects which shot to use places a check mark on the upper portion of the score card for the players shot selected. **YOU MUST USE TWO (2) TEE SHOTS FROM EACH PLAYER, ONE MUST BE USED ON THE FRONT NINE AND ONE ON THE BACK NINE!** All players then drop a ball within one-club-length of the selected shot (**no closer to the hole** and with **no improvement** in lie) and everyone hits again. For the purpose of this Tournament, the term “Drop” is equivalent to “Place”.

Examples:

1. If the selected shot is in a hazard (e.g. sand trap), everyone **MUST** hit from the hazard.
2. When on the green, the ball is marked, and everyone **MUST** putt from within on club head of that spot (no closer to the hole).
3. If the selected shot is barely outside the fairway and in the rough (even if the fairway is within one club-length), everyone **MUST** hit from the rough.
4. If the selected shot is partially buried in the sand trap (i.e. fried egg lie). Everyone **MUST** hit from a similar buried lie.

All subsequent holes will be played as outlined above and scored accordingly.

Total Team Scores on each of the 18 holes will be entered on the bottom row of the score card and the grand totals at the end. The team with the lowest grand total will be the winning team.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Prizes will be awarded to the first-place team. Also, for **“Closest to the pin” with your first shot and on the green: hole # 5 for the women, hole # 8 for the men, “The longest drive” in the fairway (for Men & Women), on hole #18. No Mulligans can be used for these holes.** Clarify any questions you may have with the Tournament Committee before the start of play.

“MULLIGANS” may be purchased from the Committee for 6 for \$10 and no more than **6 per player.** **The Mulligans may be played 3 on the front 9 and 3 on the back 9, (other than the longest drive and closest to the pin holes) but only by the person who purchased them.** The team captain will account for all mulligan tickets purchased by their respective teams.
